## REGISTRATION AND RE-REGISTRATION FOR INCLUSION ON THE DIRECT ALLOCATION SYSTEM (DAS) DATABASE AT THE MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

Pursuant to Clause 3.1.1 of the Guidelines for Engagement of Consultants on the Direct Allocation System (DAS) by the Projects Allocation Committee (PAC), registration of consultants wishing to be considered for inclusion in the roster system is now open to all 100% Citizen owned architectural, engineering and quantity surveying consultancies shall register in only one discipline.

Consultants previously registered with the PAC are also required to re-register in line with the requirements of the new Guidelines, whereas multi-disciplinary consultancies shall be required to forego other disciplines and choose only one which the Practicing Principal(s) shall be qualified in to remain with. Consultants have been given a grace period of up to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019 to comply with the requirements of the new guidelines, after which non-compliant consulting firms will not be considered for allocation through the Direct Allocation System until the comply.

The information that must be provided by the interested firms in order to be considered for registration in the Roster is as per Clause 3.2 on Eligibility in the PAC Guidelines. Copies of the Application Form together with the PAC Guidelines may be collected at Office 018 (Ground Floor) at the address indicated below. Alternatively, these are available at the respective Regulatory Authorities.
